Mr. Cutaia serves on the Board of Directors of Wolf-Gordon Holdings, Inc., among several other companies and organizations, is a Member of the Board of Trustees of the New York Institute of Technology, and is the Founder and Executive Director of the United States Chapter of Innocence in Danger, a non-profit, international organization dedicated to the protection and rehabilitation of children who have been victims of trafficking and abuse.
